

## 5 Questions Ask Before Hiring a Seattle DUI Lawyer

It is a bad idea and not recommended to hire a lawyer who has little to no experience with DUI cases. You want to have a Seattle DUI Attorney who knows how to stay up to date with all the legal changes that are always happening.

How do I know you stay up to date on DUI legislation and best practices? Do you go to conferences or events?

Science and law always mix and many new cases are being tried without the BAC being admitted into court. Does the Seattle Lawyer you interview even know this is beating the prosecution? You want a winning trial attorney who stays on top of all the current laws, regulations and rules. Washington state requires lawyers to meet specific continuing legal education classes. Ask your potential attorney if he or she focuses on DUI training or general law practice areas?

Does the attorney encourage his clients to enter into a plea agreement versus trying the actual case?

Finding a competent Seattle DUI attorney to fight for you inside and outside of the courtroom demonstrates a high level of proficiency. Your DUI defense attorney should be able to confidently answer any question you may have before making up your mind about a trial jury or entering into a plea bargain. The state will have evidence against you and your defense attorney needs to explain to you so you understand what the process will be like and how to best proceed.

Can the attorney take care of my criminal DUI case in addition to my driver's license suspension with the DOL?

You fight two cases - one is the administrative civil case with the DOL and the other is the criminal case with the state.

How many years have you defended DUI cases?

Consider the amount of experience the lawyer has. One smart idea to consider is making sure the lawyer you want to hire actually focuses on DUI defense or at least a bulk of it.

Remember to take all of these factors into consideration and avoid choosing DUI lawyers based solely on their fees. Paying more for an experienced attorney will be worth it when you avoid high court costs, penalties and punishments that result from a conviction.
